Informational Session on Request for Information January 19, 2011

The New England States Committee on Electricity (NESCOE) will hold an informational session on the Request for Information (RFI) issued in support of meeting New England's renewable energy goals cost-effectively. The purpose of the informational session is to briefly review the RFI process and answer questions from potential respondents about the RFI.

The informational session will be held on January 19, 2011 at the Courtyard Marriott in Marlborough, Massachusetts. The session will begin at 3:00 p.m. and conclude no later than 5:00 p.m.

NESCOE thanks ISO-New England (ISO-NE) for allowing NESCOE to hold the RFI informational session jointly with ISO-NE's January 19, 2011 Planning Advisory Committee (PAC) meeting.

In order to ensure sufficient logistical support for the informational session (*e.g.*, room size, dial-in telephone lines, etc.), persons planning to attend the RFI informational session must register as follows:

- If you are able to register for an ISO-NE PAC meeting: All persons planning to attend the RFI informational session who are able to register with ISO-NE for a PAC meeting must register for the January 19, 2011 PAC meeting at ISO-NE Training and Event Network (even if attendance will be limited to the RFI informational session).
